Assemblies of God Teen Bible Quiz • December 2017

While we often hear quizzers mention in their pre-match prayer that it's not about winning (and ultimately that's very true!), the fact remains that winning is fun. Winning teams and students having fun also tends to attract more students to our Bible Quiz ministry. Of course, the biggest key to excellent quizzing is accurate and timely memorization. So the question is, "How can we encourage and motivate complete and on time memorization?"

After some pre-season brainstorming, we created a challenge called "Step it Up". We are only three and half months into the quiz year, but so far it's a great success! The basic idea was to design a big wall display with steps going from the floor to the ceiling and each step represents one week's worth of memorization. Each league meet is on its own step as you work your way up. Every quizzer from all three divisions has a cool looking laminated Converse shoe with their picture on it. When they show up for practice, if they can quote their assigned verses for that week (with no more than one mistake for every three verses), their shoe "steps up." Everyone who moves up every step before the league meet is rewarded with whatever has been announced in advance. Our first reward was a trip to an awesome trampoline park and ninja training course. Our next reward will be an escape room (thanks Groupon!). Other ideas are a swimming party, a bonfire and cookout, whirly ball, ice skating, or a restaurant. Obviously, some things are much pricier than others, so you have to do what works for your ministry. We've been blessed with some generous donors who sponsor our outings, but there are plenty of rewards that are budget friendly that can motivate your quizzers to step it up!

I love the beginning of our practices when everyone is coming in, grabbing their quote sheet, and finding an adult to quote to. (And do you know that not allowing access to the donut table until they've quoted is very motivating? Ha!) The Step it Up Challenge has proven to be a great way to stay on track, record and display progress, promote consistent studying, allow for positive peer pressure, reward those quizzers who are putting forth their best, and most of all to get God's Word in our young people's hearts. In my coaching book, that's a BIG win!

NUTS & BOLTS

- Master Memorization Award. All of the Gospel of Mark must be quoted consecutively, in one sitting, within a 60-minute time limit, beginning with Mark Chapter one, verse one, and continuing through Mark 16 verse 20. The quizzer is permitted 7 mistakes for the entirety of the material.
- Both National Memorization names, Master Memorization names and Discipleship names must be submitted by the <u>District Bible Quiz Coordinators (DBQC)</u> to NYM by <u>MONDAY, APRIL 30, 2018 2:00PM</u>
 <u>CST</u>. <u>Must be E-Mailed to BQ@Ag.org</u> (Forms do not need to be submitted-just the names, church names, city, state.) Check with your DBQC when your District Deadline is, as most have an earlier date to hand out trophies and plaques.

- National BQ Finals will be held at Calvary Church, Naperville, IL. July 1-6, 2018. Everyone will be at the same hotel and the cost will be \$89.00 a night and includes a free hot breakfast, free parking and an indoor swimming pool. We also will have meeting rooms for the quizzers to fellowship in the evenings. Registration cost for National BQ Finals will remain the same again for 2018.
- Adult quizzing at National Finals. Veteran: Mark Chapters 1-5 for 192 verses. Novice: Mark Chapters 1-3 for 108 verses.
- We are updating the NYM BQ Website at https://youth.ag.org/participate/bible-quiz and will be an ongoing process over the next few months. One nice feature is now quizzers who would like to access their BQ Scholarship money can simply go to the "Invest Tab" and click on "Scholarships" and then "Click here to fill out the scholarship funds request form" Then simply submit online!
