Starting with National Finals 2017, at the banquet:

- 1 name from each region will be drawn for the quizzers receiving the Discipleship Award. The 8 quizzers will each receive a \$500.00 Scholarship for any post high school education.
- 1 name from each region will be drawn for the "A" Division quizzers receiving the National Memorization Award. The 8 quizzers will each receive a \$500.00 Scholarship for any post high school education.
- The National Finals Champions will each receive \$1,000.00 per person (instead of the current model of a total of \$2,500 per team) for any post high school education.

In 1996, Pastor Mark Batterson of National Community Church was walking by a dilapidated building near Union Station in Washington D.C. It was a crack house and it had been neglected for twenty-five years.

"I felt like God said, this would make a wonderful coffeehouse," Mark remembered. So, for the next six years, Mark and his church would regularly go out to the property and persistently prayed for it. They prayed also that God would provide the several million dollars it would take to purchase and renovate the property. In 2002, God answered those prayers. The church received the money and submitted a bid for the property. Miraculously they got the property even though four other potential buyers had outbid the church.

In 2006, after four years of planning and renovation, Ebenezer's coffeehouse opened. It became a highly popular gathering spot and financially viable business. Ebenezer's' profits have helped fund more than 30 mission trips worldwide. The building is used for Saturday night church services and is the modern day "well" where people congregate and meet Jesus.
