STOP PROCRASTING!!

“There is nothing I cannot master with the help of Christ who gives me strength.” (Philippians 4:13 JB)

The Bible gives us five actions we can take to stop procrastinating:

1. Stop making excuses. “The lazy man is full of excuses” (Proverbs 22:13 LB). What have you been saying you’re going to do “one of these days”? What do you make excuses about? The number one excuse I hear is, “When things settle down, then I’m going to ...” Things will never settle down. You must make a choice to prioritize what is important.
2. Start today. Not next month, next week, or tomorrow. “Never boast about tomorrow. You don’t know what will happen between now and then” (Proverbs 27:1 GNT). None of us is guaranteed a tomorrow.
3. Establish a planned schedule. Proverbs 13:16 says, “A wise man plans ahead. A fool doesn’t” (LB). If you fail to plan, you’re planning to fail. You need to designate some specific time slots each week for the things you need to do. Whatever it is, put it on your calendar. And if it’s a big task, break it down into small pieces. Break it into bite-size pieces.
4. Face your fears. We hate to admit we have fears, because we think they’re a sign of weakness. But fear is a sign of humanity. Only fools are not afraid. You’ve heard it said, “Courage is not the absence of fear; it’s moving ahead in spite of our fears.” The Bible says there is nothing you cannot master with the help of Christ who gives you strength.
5. Focus on what you gain, not the pain. There are very few things in life that are easy. You must push through the frustration and look at the gain beyond the pain. Concentrate on how good you’re going to feel once you’ve finished the task.

Galatians 6:9 says, “Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.” Jesus never said life would be easy. There will be sacrifice and commitment. But there is tremendous reward when we do the things he calls us to do.

ADVICE TO A NEW COACH

1. Encourage your quizzers if at all possible to study the same time and in the same place every day. It is easier to develop a habit of studying regularly when they study the same time and place.
 2. Get your quizzers to personally set goals, and then expect them to work to meet those goals. Your quizzers will work harder when they know their coach expects them to work to meet a goal that they themselves set.
 3. Ask lots of questions of other coaches. When you go to competitions and play teams with more experienced coaches, ask them what they do. Ask them how their quizzers study, what questions they use, how long they practice, etc. This can be your greatest resource if you are willing to ask questions.

NEW VENTURE WITH THE JBQ MINISTRY

Mark Entzminger, the National Children’s director and I met in Louisville in August and had a conversation about bridging the gap between JBQ and BQ. At the end of the meeting we decided to make available 100 questions over the 4 chapters from the Gospel of Mark that would cover the Experience material next season. I called Kent Kloefkorn immediately and within a week the question writing team had written and edited 100 questions over Mark. This will be primarily for those in JBQ that have their Master Seal as early as 2nd, 3rd grade and 4th grade in some districts. I contacted Scott Norquest, the JBQ and BQ Coordinator in Ohio to see if they would be willing to add these questions to their JBQ questions. Scott is excited about trying this out later this season. We still would like to get at least one other JBQ District to experiment with this. There are several different options that we believe would be a blessing to both ministries.
