1 Corinthians 16:1–4; 2 Corinthians 8:1–15; 9:12–15 Are you a generous and sacrificial giver? If you have any income through an allowance, birthday money, job, etc., make it a practice for at least four months to tithe. Read a Speed the Light and <a href="#">Missionary Testimony</a> . Pray and set a goal for Speed the Light—Project Rescue. Click <a href="#">here</a> to learn more about Speed the Light—Project Rescue and click <a href="#">here</a> to give. Keep track of your giving and let your leader know how much you gave when you submit your Discipleship Award.			
2 Corinthians 1:3–7; 2:15 Paul said that the troubles and hardships that he had faced in the past were for the comfort of those that he would later minister to. He also said that we are the aroma of Christ to the world around us. Use your life experience to minister to and/or help someone that you know. When you have completed this application send a note of what you did and the result to your DBQC or youth leader.			
2 Corinthians 1:13 Write out your personal testimony in a clear and concise way that is easy for people to understand. Practice giving your testimony. Pray that the Lord will give you opportunity to lead someone to Christ. Read the book "Gospelize" written by Greg Stier.			
2 Corinthians 4:5–18; 6:4–10 The life of a missionary is not easy. Pray and fast one meal a month for three missionaries over a three-month period. You can choose missionaries your church already supports or find missionary families at <a href="http://www.agwm.com">www.agwm.com</a> . Send a note/email to each missionary letting them know you are praying for them.			
1 Corinthians 1:1; 4:1,2 In the first verse of 1 Corinthians, Paul identifies himself as an apostle of Jesus Christ. When we introduce ourselves, it should also be apparent that we are Christians. Read the book "Until All Know" written by Heath Adamson.			
1 Corinthians 9 Write a 400-word report on how current missionaries around the world are putting aside their own comforts and preferences to win the lost. How does God call you to do the same? When you are finished, submit your report at <a href="http://ba.ag.org">ba.ag.org</a> .			
1 Corinthians 11:23,34 Assist those in your church in celebrating the Lord's death and resurrection. Talk to your pastor about volunteering to serve communion to your congregation in one of the weekly services during the 2019–2020 season. (If this application is not possible due to a denied request to serve communion, go to <a href="http://ba.ag.org">ba.ag.org</a> for an alternate application point.)
